II. CONSIDERATION OF WORK SESSION BUSINESS

1. **Republic Services** (formerly Allied Waste Industries, Inc) Solid Waste Collection and Disposal Agreement **ending September 30, 2016**; may be extended/renewed for two (2) additional consecutive five (5) year periods.

2. **Current Residential Services and Base Rate (curbside collections):**

a. **Solid Waste/Garbage** - A reasonable number of bags, designated for refuse, not exceeding thirty (30) pounds each, one time per week of each residential unit, which refuse shall be collected and disposed of on the Drop Off Day for each residential unit to which service is provided.

b. **Recycling** - In an effort to reduce landfilled material and as an integral part of this agreement, Contractor shall, as part of the services to the City, provide for and maintain a recycling program for each residential unit. Currently Contractor sponsors a program known as Single-Stream Recycling which provides for the curbside recycling collection of:
